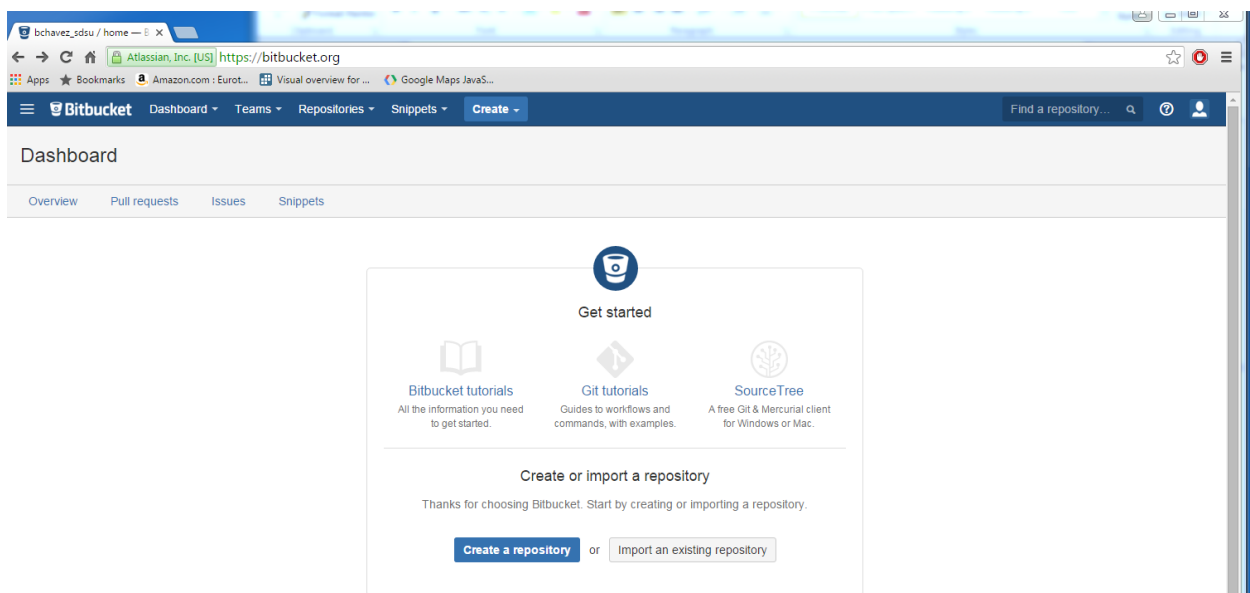


Preface: Git is a very useful tool for version control as it tracks changes you make to any programming scripts like .do files and .txt files.

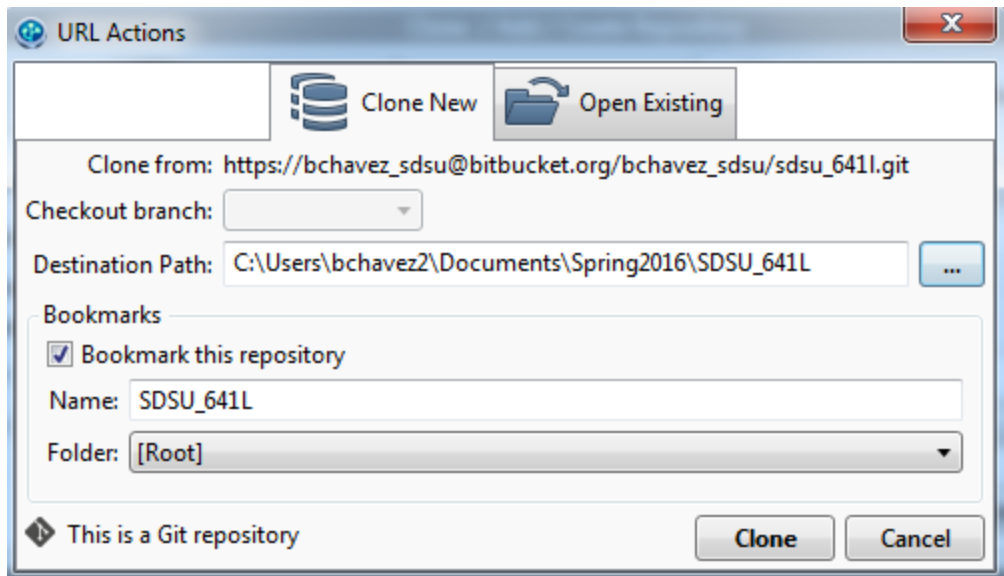
✓ Get started using the SourceTree client

1. Download Atlassian SourceTree, a free Git and Mercurial client. Then it's just one click to clone!
2. Clone in SourceTree

1. Download SourceTree

2. Click on Clone in SourceTree once you've downloaded SourceTree. This will make the following window pop up:
